Other winners of awards include the Yorkshire Terrier, York, for Conversion to Pub Use. The Best Refurbished Pub was the Racecourse in Salford and the English Heritage award was presented to the Prestoungrange Gothenburg, Prestonpans, Scotland.

The Joe Godwin Award – named after late Pub Design Award judge Mr Godwin – reserved for outstanding refurbished street-corner locals, was won by the Yarborough Hunt, Brigg, Lincolnshire.
