Trustees Report

The Trustees submit their fifth Report and Financial Statements for the year ended May 31st, 2007 for the charity's activities across the former baronial lands.

The year saw a most encouraging growth in donations which has enabled the Trustees to discuss substantial grants for the support of the Arts Festival in 2007 / 2008 / 2009. These are most particularly focussed on the celebration of the heritage of Prestonpans Pottery and the growing creative and educational opportunities afforded by the Three Harbours Festival in Prestonpans Port Seton and Cockenzie. And, as in the current year, support for the art classes, painting of the town's historical murals, Burriss Bursary and the Pipes and Drums will continue.

The Prestonpans recent twinning with Barga in Tuscany has also led to opportunities for arts and cultural exchanges in 2008 which the Trustees wish to encourage.

Campaigns to recruit new Friends of the Trust have continued during the year and will be further advanced into the future as more and more indwellers come to appreciate the work which is being undertaken.

Results

The surplus of income over expenditure for the year amounted to £24,035 (2005 - £31,213).

Close Company

The Company is a close company within the provisions of the Income and Corporation Taxes Act 1988. The Directors rely on Sections 247-249 of the Companies Act 1985 entitling them to deliver modified accounts.


