Prestoungrange Arts Festival (2006) Limited Directors Report for the year ended 31st December 2010

2010 saw the completion by the Festival of The Battle of Prestonpans 1745 Tapestry. At 104 metres it is claimed as the longest in the world and has gone on to receive endorsement from the Maire de Bayeux and many more. The Tapestry was undertaken by the Festival on behalf of the Battle of Prestonpans 1745 Trust which has developed a programme of exhibitions across Scotland and south of the border, with Canada scheduled for 2012. By year end 2011 some 100,000 visitors are predicted.

The enthusiasm generated by Andrew Crummy's brilliant artwork has inspired Alexander MacCall-Smith to sponsor The Great History of Scotland tapestry and the Festival itself to commence a 25 location Scotlish Diaspora Tapestry, beginning with Barga and Gothenburg.

The embroiderer's art should not overshadow so much else that was also achieved in 2010. The Murals Fest in Cuthill Park continued and new murals were commissioned for the Labour Club and a second at Prestonpans railway Station. The Murals Restoration Programme continued, as did the Prestoungrange Arts Classes - with growing participation at their Belfield Workshop. Andrew Dallmeyer wrote the musical Miners' Gala to assist in the Community Council's campaign for a Miners' Memorial in The Pans and it was given several performances by the Prestoungrange Players. They also offered the now traditional Roy Pugh 'Witch' play at Hallowe'en.

The Burriss Bursaries for 2010/ 2011 saw a competition to create artdeco images for a successful joint 3Harbours/ PAFS 2011 Calendar. The two other Belfield Workshops opposite the Prestoungrange Gothenburg were also given over for 12 months to lead artists Tom Ewing and Adele Robertson - the latter to include pottery activity there once again some 80 years after Belfield's closed.

Results

The operating deficit for the year amounted to £808
