

Minutes of the 12th Meeting of the Baron Courts of Prestoungrange & Dolphinstoun held at ALAQ, #20-16/18 MacArthur Parade, Main Beach, Queensland, Australia on April 1st 2000

Agreed: 1.1 That these were a true record.

2. Matters Arising

Confirmed:

Agreed: 2.2 That the Baron of Prestoungrange should carefully edit

the wordage at the WebSite forthwith under Introduction and

Visions and append hereto.

Confirmed: 2.3 (Minute 00/10-11/6.2) That the budget proposed by

Jane Bonnar for the Virtual Pottery Exhibition was acceptable

but that further details were awaited for the kiln project.

3. Postcards of the McNab Paintings

Confirmed: 3.1 That when these were shortly available they would be

offered for sale at the Industrial Museum at a price that sought

to recover their expense.

4. Publication of the Booklets for the 2000 Project for Schools

Agreed: 4.1 That in the absence of an 'external' publisher,

Prestoungrange University Press would produce the booklets,

and that typesetting should proceed apace with Malcolm

Pearce/ Centraprint (using the same formatting as for the recent The Manor of Milton & the Scottish Feudal Baronies booklet), with final agreement on the ascription to the Baronial Court

thereon outstanding.

5. Burke's Landed Gentry: 2000 Scotland Volume

Tabled: 5.1 The Entries proposed by Peter Dewar, Editor in Chief, for

the two barons.

6. Preparation of Year end accounts to April 5th 2000

Confirmed: 6.1 That the Procurator Fiscal would be preparing the first set

of accounts for the Courts for audit and taxation purposes to

April 5th 2000.

7. Dates and Venues of Next Meetings

Agreed: 7.1 That the next and 13th Meeting would be held on the

Baronial Foreshore to coincide with the Schools' Graffiti Contest

on June 2nd 2000.

7.2 That shortly after that date, the 14th Meeting should be held in Oxford to inaugurate the Baronial regalia with Paul

Colbert as an invited guest.
